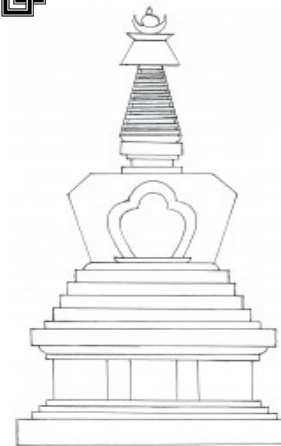
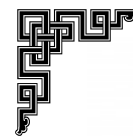
STUPA OF THE PILE OF LOTUS:

It was built to commemorate the Buddha in Lumbini, where he made seven steps in each of four directions and from which the lotuses appeared.



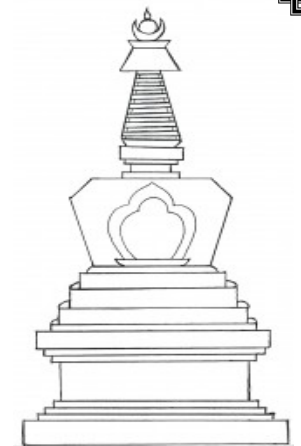
STUPA OF THE AWAKENING OR VICTORY ON MARA:

It commemorates the victory of the Buddha on Mara and his awakening under the Bodhi tree in Bodhgaya.



STUPA OF THE MIRACLES:

Built by Litisjis to commemorate the supernatural victory of the Buddha on non Buddhist (Tirthikas) in the wood of Jéavana near Sharvasti.



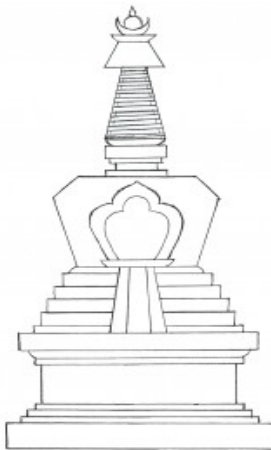
STUPA OF THE COMPLETE VICTORY:

Built by Dévas, it commemorates the fact that the Buddha when he reached the age of 80, extended his life by three months in the city of Vaishali, at the request of monk Tsunda.



STUPA OF THE NUMEROUS DOORS:

It commemorates the first tour of Dharma wheel given by the Buddha at Park of Gazelles in Sarnath (near Varanasi)



STUPA OF THE DESCENT OF THE DIVINE KINGDOM:

Commemorates the summer retreat during which the Buddha taught his mother's reincarnation in the heavenly realm of Tushita. It also commemorates his descent from this kingdom to the city Sankasya.



STUPA OF THE RECONCILIATION:

It commemorates the moment when the buddha reconciled two factions of Sangha who quarrelled in the wood of Banbois Véluvana, near Rajagriha (Magadha)



STUPA OF THE PARANIRVANA:

Commemorates the paranirvana of Buddha at Kushinagar, which is the city indicated by Rabjam-pa as being a very powerful place for visitors.
